- Develop and/or contribute creative works that align with Opus 1's mission.
- Support ongoing projects like **Music of the Heart** and **Everyone is an Artist** by offering creative input or participating in program activities.

Collaboration & Innovation

- Collaborate with the EVP of Projects & Programs and program officers to ensure seamless integration of operational support for all initiatives.
- Partner with other Artist Ambassadors, staff, and stakeholders to develop new ideas and initiatives for outreach and awareness.
- Participate in strategic planning for programs and campaigns to ensure a global impact.
